Minutes of the Ordinary Meeting of the Stow Bardolph Parish Council held at Stow Bridge Village Hall on Tuesday 9th July 2019 at 7.30pm

1. To Receive apologies for absence

1.1 Apologies were accepted from Mr R Hudson, Mr B Long & Mr H Humphrey.

2. To receive any declarations of Interest in items on the agenda

2.1 None.

3. To approve and sign the minutes of the meeting held 21st May 2019

3.1 Proposed by Mr D Barnes and seconded by Mr G Bishop, all agreed that the minutes, having been properly circulated and exhibited, be accepted as a true record of the proceedings. The Chairman thereupon signed the minutes.

4. Clerk's report (for information only)

- 4.1 The Annual Governance and Accountability Return (AGAR) had been completed and the Exception Certificate sent to the external auditor. All required information has been uploaded to the Council website.
- 4.2 The Clerk has been sorting through old documents, some of which need to be stored at the Norfolk Record Office. A Document Retention Policy will be produced in time to be considered at the next Council meeting.
- 4.3 All other matters which the Clerk has been working on are included on the agenda.

5. Open Forum for public participation

5.1 No members of the public were present at the meeting.

6. To discuss any Highway Matters

- 6.1 The Clerk had met with Mr Wallace from the Highways Dept. to review previous items reported and identify any new issues. A summary of the meeting can be read here: (insert link) and can also be supplied by the Clerk on request.
- 6.1a Four new sites for the SAM2 have been identified and agreed with Mr Wallace:
 - Lady Drove (outside Hermitage/Wash Farm new post required)
 - Low Road (outside no 61 suitable lamp post available)
 - The Drove (opposite no ?? suitable 40 repeater sign available)
 - Holme Road (outside Woodlakes new post required)

The Council resolved to purchase one new post for the site at Lady Drove, plus additional brackets and clips for the sites at Low Road and The Drove. The site at Holme Road to be considered again at a later date.

6.1b The Clerk had consulted Mr Wallace regarding signage for Stow Bridge, and he estimated a cost of approximately £250 per sign. Mr Wallace suggested the Council consider making an application to the Parish Partnership Fund for a grant towards these costs.

- 6.2 Several hedges appear to be overhanging the roads around the parish; The Clerk and Cllr Bishop will review this and any properties where this is deemed to be an issue will receive a letter asking them to take action.
- 6.3 Information regarding the Parish Partnership Fund had been received; It was agreed that the Clerk should proceed with an application for a grant towards signage for Stow Bridge, which will include asking the Highways Dept. to provide a quotation for four signs.
