

NORFOLK COUNTY COUNCIL proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Order affecting the Stow Road from its junction with Burnt Lane for 1650 metres southwards in the PARISH OF WIGGENHALL ST MARY MAGDALEN because of vegetation clearance and ecological survey works.

The road will be temporarily closed (except for access) between 09:00 and 16:00 hours from 25th January 2021 to 26th January 2021 and between 09:00 and 16:00 hours on 22nd February 2021 for the duration of the works, expected to be 3 days within the period.

Alternative route is via: Stow Road, Church Road, Station Road, School Road, Downham Road, Watlington Road, Holme Road, The Causeway, West Head Road, Low Road (Runcton Holme/ Wiggenhall St. Mary Magdalen/ Watlington/ Stow Bardolph).


(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order).

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
